ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW

Eneza Education makes kids in rural Africa smarter by offering a virtual tutor and teacher's assistant that works on a simple low-cost mobile phone. Students read lessons, take adaptive quizzes, view mobile report cards and ask live teachers questions. Teachers get reports on their students, assign them exercises, and receive tips on classroom management. Eneza encourages collaborative education by connecting parents, students and teachers with real-time feedback

Toni is the co-founder and CEO of Eneza Education. Eneza's goal is to make 50 Million students across rural Africa smarter through low-cost mobile technology.
