Claudia's previous work includes developing youth leadership, supporting struggles for economic justice, and strengthening nonprofit organizations. Her book "The Spiritual Activist: Practices to Transform Your Life, Your Work, and Your World" (Penguin Compass 2002) is a practical guide to individual and social transformation through spirit and faith. Claudia has a master's degree in Public Policy from Duke University and is a Rockefeller Foundation Next Generation Leadership Fellow. She practices meditation and teaches Kripalu yoga.
