For the long term, TWEET works with stakeholders to mainstream advocacy and build awareness. Its goal is to accelerate the social and economic development and well-being of the transgender community in India.

Shaman Gupta, co-chair of the TWEET Foundation, identifies as a transman and has been working for trans rights since 2016. Shaman has worked with thousands of young trans people across India to provide them with legal, health, and employment support. Shaman has also focused on community building and regional leadership building of transmen with support of grants from the UNDP, the International Trans Fund, and the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment of India. He was awarded the Dalai Lama Fellowship 2020 for his work with the transmen community in India. Shaman has worked across various roles, including operations, product design, fundraising, and business development.
