ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW

Bena Care reduces healthcare costs for chronically ill patients and their families by establishing a network of healthcare workers who deliver affordable home-based nursing and in-home therapy. Bena Care also builds caregiving skills in family caregivers, the vast majority of whom are women. Through this model, Bena Care not only eases the economic and emotional burden on families, but also addresses the issue of unpaid caregiving performed by women in these communities. Bena Care's impact reverberates across communities — significantly reducing healthcare costs for thousands of families.

Naom Monari is the founder and chief executive officer of Bena Care and a visionary leader with a commitment to social justice. Through Bena Care, Naom is building a movement of thousands of healthcare workers who are disrupting the healthcare systems that enable extreme poverty in Kenya and beyond.
