It breaks down barriers to care, particularly for underserved groups, by partnering with healthcare professionals and fostering a supportive community. Omgyno's mission is to establish a global network of inclusive, affordable, and innovative healthcare solutions for all. It envisions a world where sexual and reproductive health are free from stigma and inequality.

Doreen Toutikian is a social innovator, human-centered design expert, and feminist advocate from Beirut, Lebanon. Driven by her passion to break systemic barriers, Doreen founded Omgyno. She has worked extensively with international NGOs across the MENA region, focusing on gender equity, cultural development, and community-driven change.
